

Coronado Optimist Foundation, Inc. Articles of Incorporation

Article I

The name of this corporation is the Coronado Optimist Foundation, Inc.

Article II

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

Article III

The specific purposes of this corporation are to:

- (a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of education and moral values of youth and for charitable purposes by the distribution of funds for such purposes;
- (b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes;

Article IV

The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is: John T. Freeman, 845 B Avenue, Coronado, CA 92118-2615.

Article V

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of IRS Section 501(c)(3).

Article VI

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person

Article VII

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit foundation with tax-exempt status under IRS Section 501(c)(3) which is dedicated to the educational support of the youth of Coronado.

Article VIII

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.
